| <b>Creative Composers</b>  | compose, notate, and perform an original piece                    |
| <b>Listen and Learn</b>    | listen to 5 classical works and complete corresponding worksheets |
| <b>Nimble Note Namers</b>  | a timed flashcard race to name notes on the staff                 |
| <b>Rockin' Rhythms</b>     | complete and pass a rhythm test with 80% accuracy                 |
| <b>Excellent Ears</b>      | complete and pass an ear-training test with 80% accuracy          |
| <b>Musical Masterminds</b> | complete and pass a theory test with 80% accuracy                 |
| <b>Flying Fingers</b>      | learn pentascales, scales, chords, and arpeggios                  |
| <b>Mighty Memorizers</b>   | memorize 3 pieces   |
| <b>Perfect Practicers</b>  | have a perfect practice record for 4 weeks in a row               |

Just as athletes train in a variety of areas to excel at their sport, musicians need to learn many different skills to master their instrument. This summer, as you watch athletes compete in events in the Olympic Games, you can also compete in different musical events in the MUSIC Olympics!

As you complete each event, you will earn awards on your way to becoming an All Star Musician!

There are 10 different events. Students may choose to compete in as many events as they wish. Students will compete in different "events" throughout the summer by mastering different skills during their home practice each week, and then perform these skills for their teacher at their lessons. The teacher will pass the student in each event as they demonstrate the skills in their lessons. There is no limit on how many times a student can try to pass an event.

Students will earn a ribbon for each event they complete. In addition, they will receive a final prize depending on the total number of events completed:



- 2 events: Certificate
- 4 events: Bronze medal
- 6 events: Silver medal
- 8 events: Gold medal
- 10 events: All-Star Trophy



All events must be passed off by your lesson time the week of August 25, with no exceptions.
